Grand Theatre Field Trip

As has become tradition, we will be taking our show on the road to Elizabeth, PA at the Grand Theatre. The date for this field trip is Thursday, March 18th (pending approval). Students will perform twice; one school day matinee and one evening performance. Students will need to bring a lunch but a pizza dinner will be provided. This trip also serves as our cast party. Costumes & Props

We are in need of some items that we have been unable to locate. Every student involved in the production needs an overcoat for one scene in our play. If you have something that would be appropriate for your child to wear please have them bring it to the Saturday rehearsal for approval. Please also mark a name in the collar with masking tape so it can be returned to you. All students must also provide their own shoes for the production. Orphans and Hoovervilles can wear jazz shoes, jazz boots, or ankle boots. Warbuck's staff needs tan character shoes or tan jazz shoes. All men need black dress shoes or jazz shoes. Ensemble members need black jazz shoes or flats. If you have questions about costumes or shoes please see Mrs. Hawk or Mrs. Sukal after rehearsals. One larger prop we are still looking for is a rolling laundry hamper (big enough for someone to be inside of. If anyone has any leads on where we can find this please contact Mrs. Hawk asap.
