Garden Activity

"CELERY STALK SEEDLING"

MATERIALS

- One celery bunch
- Bottom 2-3 inches of a celery stump
- Clean plastic plate, yogurt container or small cup
- Water
- Optional: potting soil mix



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Carefully cut the celery stalks leaving 2-3 inches of the stems attached to the bottom of the stump.
2. Place the stump in a small container in a sunny spot like a windowsill.
3. Add a thin layer of water so the bottom of the stump is wet. Do not immerse the entire stump.
4. Watch as the celery stem starts to grow. Small leaves will appear in the center of the stump after 2-3 days.
5. Water the celery stalk seedling every other day.

IDEA:

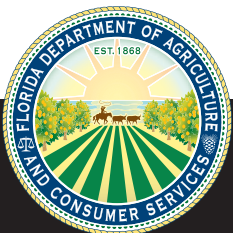
Plant one celery seedling in a small pot of soil.
Compare the growth of this plant to the one in the water!
