

Keystone Exam Skylert Announcement 2018-2019

Good Afternoon,

The following is important information regarding the upcoming Keystone Exams that will take place at Baldwin High School from May 13, through May 20, 2019.

The **Biology Keystone Exams** are scheduled for Monday, **May 13th**, and Tuesday, **May 14th**. All 9th grade students and students currently enrolled in our Biology courses are required to take the exam.

The **Literature Keystone Exams** are scheduled for Wednesday, **May 15th**, and Thursday, **May 16th**. All 10th grade students and students enrolled in our English Literature courses are required to take the exam.

The **Algebra I Keystone Exams** are scheduled for Friday, **May 17th** and Monday, **May 20th**. All students who are currently enrolled in our Algebra I courses are required to take the exam.

***Any student who has not passed any of the above mentioned Keystone Exams from previous years are required to take the assessment(s) on the designated testing day(s).

A list of names of our students who are required to take the Keystone Exams will be posted outside of the Guidance Office, Main Office, and the South Cafeteria. The list will also include the locations of the testing rooms where students are to report.

Baldwin High School will operate on a 2-hour delay on all six of the testing days; however, our buses will operate as usual. Students scheduled to take the Keystone Exams are to report to school at their regular time.

Students who are not required to take Keystone Exams may choose to arrive at BHS two hours later than normal, **BUT ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR HIS/HER OWN TRANSPORTATION.**

Non-testing students may choose to ride the bus to BHS at their regular time and remain in the cafeteria while testing is in progress. Breakfast will be available to purchase in the south cafeteria and Baldwin Bean during the 2-hour delays.

Steel Center students who are scheduled to take a Keystone Exam are to **arrive at BHS at their regular time**, and report to their testing room.
